## A NOTE FROM THE VICE PRESIDENT FOR STUDENT AFFAIRS ...

The College and University Security Information Act (PA. Act 1989-73), the Drug Free Schools and Communities Act Amendment of 1989 (U.S. Public Law 010-226), the Crime Awareness Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-542), the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1988, and the Higher Education Amendments of 1998 require that certain information be distributed annually to all students and employees. All of this information can be found in the *Student Rights, Regulations, and Procedures* handbook (WWW.CLARION.EDU/STUDENTRIGHTS.PDF). Additionally, the Drug Free Schools and Communities Act is e-mailed to all students, faculty, and staff annually.

This brochure outlines important sections of the *Student Rights, Regulations, and Procedures* handbook, identifies relevant websites, and lists telephone numbers for university services. All students are responsible for complying with or knowing the contents of the handbook. *Student Rights, Regulations, and Procedures* topics include:

- student rights with regard to the classroom, student publications, and student records;
- Clarion University student regulations, policies, and procedures, including student organizations;
- the Academic Honesty Policy;
- description of regulations and laws pertaining to the unlawful possession/distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol;

- description of health risks associated with the use of illicit drugs and abuse of alcohol;
- description of drugs and alcohol treatment, rehabilitation programs, and sanctions; and
- explanation of sexual misconduct policies, procedures, and possible sanctions.

Clarion University's annual security report includes statistics for the previous three years concerning reported crimes that occurred on campus, in certain off-campus buildings owned or controlled by Clarion University, and on public property within, or immediately adjacent to, and accessible from the campus.

The report also includes institutional policies addressing campus security such as policies concerning alcohol and drug use, crime prevention, the reporting of crimes, sexual misconduct, and other matters.
